California has the largest solar market in the U.S. and has been a longtime champion of solar because of the many economic and environmental benefits it provides, including billions in local investment.

The Ivanpah solar power plant formally opened in 2014 on roughly 5 square miles of federal land near the California-Nevada border. Though it was hailed at the time as a breakthrough moment for clean ...

But as California works toward its ambitious clean energy vision, an almost counterintuitive challenge has emerged: The state is, at times, generating more solar energy than it can handle....

The California Independent System Operator (CAISO), the grid operator for most of the state, is increasingly curtailing solar- and wind-powered electricity generation as it balances supply ...

In 2022, California reportedly produced too much solar energy, wasting over 2 million megawatt-hours of electricity. Not all of the energy produced by solar is being put to good use yet.

The launch of solar power to provide power to the Majuro government, business and private customers "translates to real benefits for our customers on Majuro," Chong-Gum said.

A solar installation with an average-sized backup battery can earn an additional \$6,700 (or more) in tax credits and rebates. California's solar incentives can reduce solar panel payback time to 8 years or ...
