The continent imported 60% more solar panels from China over the past year, though a lack of reliable installation data makes it a challenge to track the true pace of deployment.

China has developed over 900 GW of wind and solar domestically over the past five years. And overseas investments have grown as well, particularly in Belt and Road countries.

The government incentives have also contributed to the curtailment of solar energy, as many of the solar projects have been built in northern and western regions of China where there is a low demand for ...
