For the upcoming fiscal year, the earmarked provision will be used to complete installation of the remaining 97 base station radios and 222 mobile radios in emergency vehicles ...

Presently, Jamaica is without an emergency telecommunication infrastructure and platform that can facilitate communication among government agencies and first responders during an emergency in a ...

Liberty Caribbean characterized the arrangement as Jamaica's first formal pairing of a terrestrial mobile operator with a satellite communications provider to enable seamless, device-native ...

For nationwide communications purposes, it is planned to allocate 109 fixed radios to government agencies, police stations, fire stations and hospitals, 302 mobile radios for fire department and ...

All emergency services are prepared for the hurricane. TEST runs are being conducted on disaster emergency communication equipment and infrastructure which was funded by Japan ...
