In April 2023, a group of over 400 US solar industry firms petitioned Congress to uphold the pause, warning of dire financial impacts. Auxin then sued Commerce to have the moratorium ...

In August 2025, the U.S. Court of International Trade (USCIT) issued a final ruling in the case of Auxin Solar et al. v. Biden Administration, declaring that the "Proclamation 10414" - which suspended ...

Issued by the White House on 6 June 2022, this proclamation had suspended import tariffs on solar cells and modules from Cambodia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam for 24 months.

At the time of the investigation, solar panels from Southeast Asia made up 80% of supply in the United States,
