The Biden Administration has released a fact sheet detailing multiple solar panel related policies, including the removal of the bifacial solar panel exemption.

In 2022, the solar tariffs were extended, decreasing 0.25% annually to reach 14% by 2026 (U.S. President 2022). The tariff excluded solar products from Canada and Mexico. Tariffs on Chinese solar cells ...

On February 4, 2022, President Biden announced an extension and modification of the existing safeguard tariffs for an additional four years. In his announcement, the President included an exemption for bifacial solar panels.

Solar cells are not exempt from the recent reciprocal import tariffs, and recent reporting by major media outlets appears to be a mis-interpretation of government documentation.

The countervailing and anti-dumping duties are in response to a petition that a group of seven solar panel manufacturers called the American Alliance for Solar Manufacturing Trade Committee filed with ...

President Biden issued Proclamation 10779 on June 21, 2024 removing the exemption from Section 201 duties on solar cells for "bifacial solar panels" that are imported on or after June 26, at 12:01 ...
